The Grand Narrows Ferry Wharf has been recognized as a heritage property for its cultural and historical significance. A passenger and vehicle Ferry ran across the Barra Strait from 1847 until the highway bridge was opened in October 1993.



The Grand Narrows Hotel was built in 1887 to serve the needs of train travelers. The historic hotel accommodated many distinguished guests over the years including Sir John A. Macdonald, Alexander Graham Bell, Helen Keller & U.S. Presidents William Howard Taft,



Grover Cleveland and Teddy Roosevelt.

George Henry Murray was the eighth Premier of Nova Scotia. He was born in Grand Narrows on June 7 th 1861. He served as Premier for 26 years and 188 days, the longest unbroken tenure for a head of government in Canadian history.



The last regular scheduled train to cross the bridge into Grand Narrows ran in 2004. "The Bras d'Or" was a summer passenger service which ran weekly round trips between Sydney and Halifax.
